



SUMMER READING



Dear Parents,

This summer we are still requiring all 2nd-8th grade students to read books and take quizzes on them through the Accelerated Reader program. This website will be your tool this year to make sure that you are meeting requirements that we have set up for each grade level: www.arbookfind.com

Follow these instructions when searching for a book:

1. Go to www.arbookfind.com
2. Click on "Advanced Search".
3. Go to "Interest Level" and "ATOS Book level" and select the range according to your child's grade level listed below.
4. You may want to do a Topic and Subtopic search if student has a particular interest.
5. Click "Search" and look for a book that suits the student's preference.
6. If you have a book of interest and you're not sure it's an AR book, go to Quick Search and type in the title. If it's an AR book it will bring up all the information on that book.

****High School will not be doing AR for Summer Reading. They will choose a book from a specific list and be required to take a 100-point test during the first full week of school. 9th-12th grade students should refer to Google Classroom for specific instructions.**

*****Pre-school through first grade students are not required to participate in summer reading, but we do encourage parents to read to their children and ask them questions.**

Absolutely no test will be given the first week of school to students who were registered before July.

No testing will be done after the above dates until school begins. All students in grades 2nd-12th who have registered BEFORE June 30th must get their testing done within these dates. All students registered AFTER June 30th will test during the first week of school. AR grades are worth 50 points in English/Reading class.

WHEN QUIZZING:

1. Testing is done on a first-come basis.
2. Students must sign in on a sign-in sheet in the office (name, title of books, student grade level).
3. Parents are asked to not assist their child during testing.
4. Students should bring their book (incase their is a problem with testing).
5. A list of user name and passwords will be available in the office.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Due to inappropriate reading content or dark elements found in these books, material by the following authors have been deleted from our system: **J.K Rowling Stephen King, Stephenie Meyer, Sarah Ellis, Ellen Hopkins, R. L. Stine, and Christopher Pike.** All the books under the horror/thriller section will be deleted. Assembly Christian School wants to make sure that the reading material that our students choose will benefit them both morally and spiritually. However, because of a large selection of authors in the Accelerated Reader program, we are unable to go through over 100,000 books and delete those we feel are harmful reading material for students. We rely on parents to make sure that you are aware of the content of the book that your child is reading. The website, www.arbookfind.com can assist parents and students with a brief summary of the content of the book. ACS administration reserves the right to delete quizzes on books we feel are not appropriate reading. Students and parents will be notified of any deletions.

Any student caught testing for another student will make a O/F for Summer Reading and will be disciplined accordingly.
