



# SUMMER READING



## 2nd-8th grade students:

This summer we are still requiring all 2nd-8th grade students to read books and take quizzes on them through the Accelerated Reader program. This website will be your tool this year to make sure that you are meeting requirements that we have set up for each grade level: [www.arbookfind.com](http://www.arbookfind.com)

Follow these instructions when searching for a book:

1. Go to [www.arbookfind.com](http://www.arbookfind.com)
2. Click on "Advanced Search".
3. Go to "Interest Level" and "ATOS Book level" and select the range according to your child's grade level listed below.
4. You may want to do a Topic and Subtopic search if student has a particular interest.
5. Click "Search" and look for a book that suits the student's preference.
6. If you have a book of interest and you're not sure it's an AR book, go to Quick Search and type in the title. If it's an AR book it will bring up all the information on that book.

8 <sup>th</sup> grade	Middle Grades Plus (6 <sup>th</sup> +)	10+ pts must be earned	ATOS level 5.0 or higher

**\*\*\*Pre-school through first grade students are not required to participate in summer reading, but we do encourage parents to read to their children and ask them questions.**

## Summer Reading LAB HOURS:

**Test Dates: June 13th, 15th, 20th, 22nd, 27th, 29th (9:00-11:00)**

**July 11th (11:30-1:30) and July 13th (9:00-3:00)**

**Last scheduled AR testing dates is Thursday, July 13th.**

**Absolutely no test will be given during the month of August to students who were registered before July.**

No testing will be done after the above dates until school begins. All students in grades 2nd-12th who have registered BEFORE June 30th must get their testing done within these dates. All students registered AFTER June 30th will test during the month of August. AR grades are worth 50 points in English/Reading class.

## WHEN QUIZZING:

1. Testing is done on a first-come basis.
2. Students must sign in on a sign-in sheet in the office (name, title of books, student grade level).
3. Parents are asked to not assist their child during testing.
4. Students should bring their book (in case there is a problem with testing).
5. A list of user name and passwords will be available in the office.

## 9th-12th grade students:

Students will be required to come to school and login to Google with their school email address and password to access the online test (similar to the way we do AR testing). We will allow students to take one test on each novel that is selected for their grade. The highest grade earned out of the two tests will be applied to the 1st 9 weeks as a 100 point test grade. If a student only takes a test on only one novel, their grade earned on said test will automatically be the grade given for summer reading during the 1st 9 weeks. Below are the selected novels for 9th-12th grades. We will be following the Summer Reading Lab Hours that are posted above.
