FEES

- Class fees will be collected during orientation night for Prek-12th grades. Payments may also be brought to the school office during the summer, Monday-Thursday 9-3. **Class fees must be paid in full by orientation night. Any student owing class fees after orientation night will not be permitted to attend the first day of school until all fees are paid in full.**
- Technology and Facility Maintenance fees can be rolled into tuition. This option must be chosen at registration. If you choose not to roll them into tuition, these fees are due by July 29th.
- Registration fee is due at the time of enrollment. Early registration ends March 23rd. After that, registration will be \$395.00 for each student. Only the first 2 students in K-12th grades pay registration.
- Registration for K3 & K4 students is \$225.00.

Tuition Discounts

- 2nd K-12th child-15% off
- 3rd K-12th child-25% off
- 4th K-12th child-pay \$500

*If you attend Assembly Christian Center for at least one year prior, you qualify for a 5% church discount.
*K3 and K4 tuition is not eligible for any tuition discounts.

NEW STUDENTS ONLY

New students registering for grades K-12th will pay a fee of \$100.00 per student. An additional \$25.00 fee is due at the time of testing. These must be paid in the office. Families wishing to pay registration, technology and maintenance fees by credit card may do so in the office after the new student interview.
